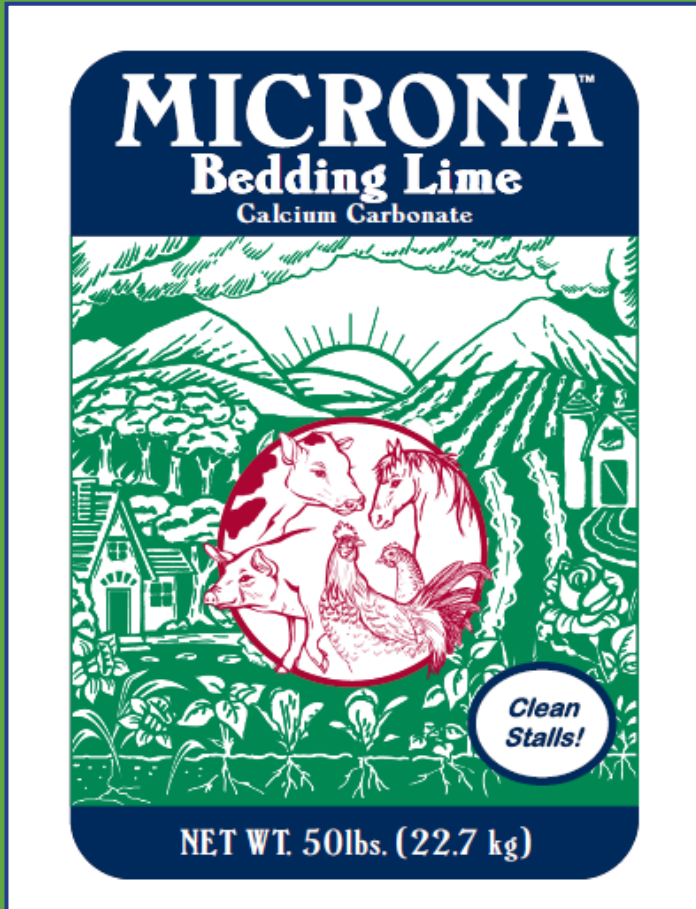

Ingredients: Ground Limestone

### Typical Particle Size Distribution

Amount passing 10 mesh sieve: 100%

Amount passing 40 mesh sieve: 100%

Amount passing 100 mesh sieve: 99%

Amount passing 200 mesh sieve: 91%

### Application Guideline

Cattle/Goats/Sheep/Horses and other large animals: 1 lb per stall every 5 to 10 days.

Hogs: 1 lb per 12 x 12 stall every 5 days; Piglets: 3 oz. per day per piglet (keeps piglets drier).

Rake off contaminated bedding as needed.
